



UPSCALING ePhyto Solution






We are <u>partnering</u> with the FAO's International Plant Protection Convention (IPPC) Secretariat to help governments make trade in plants and plant products simpler, faster and more cost-effective while protecting consumer safety. We aim to do this by supporting countries to introduce electronic phytosanitary certificates, or ePhytos.

Implementing the ePhyto solution

- reduces the risk of loss, damage or fraud to the certificates
- makes trade of agricultural and food products safer, faster and cheaper
- provides seamless ePhyto exchange with other countries
- reduces administrative burden on border agencies and businesses
- allows traders to transmit globally accepted certificates safely, securely and instantaneously



The IPPC ePhyto Solution



Single-point transmission (HUB)

Single point (HUB) exchange allows exchanges between all of the countries connected to the hub

Any new country connecting to the hub will be able to exchange certificates with all of the other connected countries






